Section 2:

For all cattle in this consignment I declare the following:

- a) All animals listed comply with current identification legislation - all animals must be double tagged with official ear tags and accompanied with a correct, corresponding passport.
- b) Passports correspond with the eartags of the animals presented – Failure to match may result in carcasses being condemned.
- c) All of the cattle listed have been produced in accordance with the Red Tractor Assurance standard and have resided on farm assured holdings for no less than the last 90 days.
- d) All of the cattle listed have been on the current holding for at least 30 days and have been resident at no more than four farms where they have been under different ownership and Farm Assurance. The animals comply with the requirements of the 2 Sisters Red Meat Codes of Practice for Beef and Veal
- e) The haulier used (if applicable) is a member of the Red Tractor or QMS Farm Assurance Haulier Scheme and the animals were fasted for at least 3 hours prior to loading
- f) All of the animals listed comply with the 2 Sisters Red Meat 'clean livestock policy'. I understand that any dirty animals may be clipped at my own expense.
- g) To the best of my knowledge withdrawal periods have been observed for all veterinary medicines and other treatments administered to the listed animals while in my and previous ownership(s). A note of any treatments, including medicated feed administered in the last 28 days is attached on a separate sheet
- h) To the best of my knowledge the animals have not been treated with quinolones or 3rd and 4th generation cephalosporins.
- i) The holding is NOT under movement restrictions for any animal disease or public health reasons (excluding TB restrictions and a 6-day (Wales & England) or 13-day (Scotland) standstill.
- j) To the best of my knowledge none of the animals listed are cloned or 1st generation progeny of cloned animals. Nor are they suffering from any disease or condition that may affect the safety of the meat derived from them. No analysis of samples taken from the animals or other animals on the holding has shown that the animals have been exposed to any disease or condition that may affect the safety of meat, or to substances likely to result in residues in meat.
